What was going on in the world in Israel? Did everyone believe the same things? Were faithful Jews affected by social trends, other religious beliefs, politics, or commerce? What might have been some of their temptations? Fears? Hopes? Come learn about all this and more, as we walk that journey to Jerusalem and the Cross with Jesus and his reluctant disciples. "Persevering With Joy During Covid." Pastor Steve will lead a 7-week study of Philippians. Philippians is Paul's most joyful letter, yet it was written from a Roman prison. Just as we face the challenges of an unending pandemic, Paul faced a difficult confinement which he did not choose. Yet within those limitations, Paul persevered with joy through his faith in Jesus Christ. Perseverance without joy equals drudgery and exhaustion; joy without perseverance is shallow and fleeting. Like Paul, how can we combine both? Spoiler alert: Paul said, "For me to LIVE is Christ." With whatever limitations we may be facing, together let's deepen our relationship with Christ through this amazing little letter. This class meets in-person (masks).

Prayer Focus:

Matt and Anna Shenk (CRU – For Richmond-Virginia) Matt and Anna lead "For Richmond," a CRU endeavor in Virginia. This fall, following on the Arrabon study, they helped many of the 80 churches with whom they are connected study *Be* the Bridge, a book study to help our region develop a shared and biblically-grounded understanding of restorative reconciliation. It's been encouraging to see followers of Christ from both sides of the political aisle learn how to have courageous and civil conversations on how to navigate complicated emotions and conversations that arise when we talk about the sin of racism in its various forms. Their prayer request right now is that they would be known as people who love the Lord passionately, and who love their neighbors incredibly well. They pray that they are known as a community of people who may be imperfect but who strive to reflect Jesus to others and provide a positive witness for Christ to the world around them. They also pray for a spirit of unity in their church in the midst of so much division in our nation.
