Notes From Justice and Mercy NPC's *Loving Our Neighbors Ministry* has numerous branches, each with different partners. Jennifer Bonovitz skillfully, tirelessly and, most important, lovingly, keeps it all moving smoothly. One such partnership is with Stop the Risk, an organization in Kensington that works with people suffering from addictions. NPC helped to procure a grant to build tiny houses there. Jennifer and others help provide lovely holiday meals for these neighbors. Another partnership is with The Mitzvah Pantry in Bala Cynwyd. Jennifer and her helpers pick up donations from local stores and take them to Bala. From there a wide variety of items are distributed at the pantry location and some are delivered to seniors. The newest branch of *Loving Our Neighbors* is in North Philly at 23rd and Ridge and it is growing quickly. Large quantities of groceries are given out to the near-by community and a local pastor comes to Jennifer's home to pick up a plethora of food and goods for his congregation. Jennifer is very thankful for the many people of NPC who give generously of their time, talents and resources. Whatever your skill set and availability, Jennifer has a spot for you that is just waiting to be filled.

WEDNESDAY NIGHT CLASSES

New Wednesday Night Study for Lent! *Rediscover Jesus*, by Matthew Kelly. This book is divided into 40 daily readings of a page or two, a Bible verse, a question to ask, a thought to ponder, and a sentence prayer. Kelly prompts us to get to know Jesus in a deeply personal way: As the carpenter from Nazareth, the itinerant preacher, the Son of God, the King of Kings and the Lord of Lords, the Lamb of God, the new Adam, the Messiah, the Alpha and the Omega, the Chosen One, the Light of the World, the God-Man who wants good things for us more than we want them for ourselves, the healer of our souls.
