Year to Date- SEP 2016

We are very thankful for your financial participation with NPC. Your gifts allow our ministry to continue, helping us to reach out with the Good News of Jesus Christ, support missions locally and around the world, teach our children and youth, and maintain our beautiful church building.

Through September, our offerings are \$57,053 behind last year's pace, and \$81,343 below budgeted pace. To reach our 2016 budget of \$1,217,000, \$477,343 (or about 39% of budget) is needed in the fourth quarter.

Spending year to date has been below budgeted pace overall (by \$28,180) and we expect to end the year spending below budget. The net YTD shortage of \$145,228 has been funded by cash on hand and our endowment.

Outside of the budgeted areas shown above, there have been \$153,018 of expenses to complete various projects around the building (funded by special gifts), and \$11, 517 for Staff Housing Support funded by our endowment.

Your gifts are an act of worship which God uses to further ministry near and far. We ask for your continued support of NPC's ministries to help bring us closer to our budgeted needs over the coming months, so we may finish the year well and enter 2017 on a strong footing. May the Lord bless you in your giving!
