These problems have been complicated and deepened by COVID-19. But Jesus and this congregation aren't going to give up, so they have found ways to minister to the everyday needs of the people during the pandemic, and in its wake (we hope). Please pray for the Lord's increasing blessing in, among and through the people of Cannon Ball and the Standing Rock Reservation in these ongoingly difficult days.
