NPC GIVING UPDATE

We are finalizing numbers through the end of October, but at the end of October giving totals just over \$750,000 of our \$1.1 million dollar budget, which is very similar to where we were at this point in 2021.

That means, we need to receive \$350,000, or 32% of the annual total, in November and December to reach our budgeted need.
