In addition to affordable housing for senior adults, **HumanGood**, provides Life plan communities (also known as continuing care retirement communities or CCRCs), which provide housing and health care on a continuum that changes as the needs of older adults change. Many of our NPC seniors have lived in the Rosemont Village community, Broomall (now Rosewood Gardens), and Rydal Park. Please pray this week for the ministry of care offered in all the HumanGood communities, that those who offer the care might be blessed in their own lives of faith and service, and those who receive the care might experience the love of God and the presence of Jesus, through the care they receive from staff members.

**Notes from Justice and Mercy:** The ministry to our brothers and sisters in Kensington continues to bless so many who are often forgotten or looked upon with disdain. Outreach workers at Project Home deliver the items our church donates and they are grateful for our support. As winter approaches, there is a need for warm coats (not wool), blankets, sweatpants and shirts, hoodies, long underwear, hats, gloves, and socks. Gently used sneakers and boots are also needed. As parts of the Kensington area gentrify, efforts are being made for these dear folks to be forced out of the area without sufficient alternatives being offered to them.
