- The Family Sahadi Mission Partnership was referred to the Missions Committee for consideration.

- To amend the NPC Benevolence Policy such that organizations receiving less than \$100,000 in annual contributions are not required to have a CPA audit but instead would provide their Form 990 for financial accountability.
