Recent Session Actions: The Session met June 18th and the following actions were approved:

- Well Rooted was approved as the missions cause for 2024 Vacation Bible Camp.
- Housing Assistance Proposal for New Senior Pastor: To alleviate the high cost of housing in the area, NPC will offer substantial housing assistance for the new Senior Pastor to purchase a home in the area. This will reduce the amount the pastor will need to contribute or borrow from outside sources to afford a home. The assistance will either be structured as a second mortgage loan from the church to the pastor or as joint ownership of the home between the pastor and the church, depending on the details of an agreement that can be worked out between the church and the pastor, once the pastor is identified. The church is willing to invest up to \$300,000 of its endowment for this purpose.
- Advertising of Housing Assistance: To reduce concerns of potential applicants about the high cost of housing in the area, the PNC may advertise that housing assistance is available and discuss the housing assistance options with candidates who are in the appropriate stage of the process.
- The Preschool budget for 2024-2025 was approved.
- Katie Kennedy was approved as the new Preschool Board Chair, replacing Carol Bellamy, who is moving to Florida.
