- Approved a revised wedding policy (ie. detailed cost breakdown)
- Approved the Found Wandering Benefit Concert offering to go to Well Rooted.
- Approved the NPC budget (less Missions) in the reduced sum of \$895,000. Also approved the Missions budget in the sum of \$211.000. This represents an overall reduction from the current budget of approximately 13%.
