NPC Finance & Stewardship Committee Update: Thanks to the extraordinary generosity of our NPC congregation, we finished the year 2024 with a much smaller budget deficit than previously anticipated. The total yearly shortfall, including non-budgeted expenses, was \$130,000, which is covered by a prior drawdown from our endowment. No additional drawdown was taken. For the first month of 2025, total offerings to the general budget are just under \$65k, at about 68% of budgeted expenses of \$95k. Thank you for your continued support.
