**The Rev. Dr. Kenneth Green** and his wife, the Rev. Dr. Tassie Green attended Narberth from 2014 – 2016 and Tassie served on our staff as the Director of Youth and Family ministries.

Ken is a Church Consultant with the Board of Pensions of the Presbyterian Church (USA). In that role, he consults with churches and presbyteries within the Synods of Lincoln Trails and Lakes & Prairies about employee compensation and benefits. He also leads seminars on preparing for ministry at regional seminaries and in preparing for retirement for pastors and church workers.

Before joining the Board in 2014, Ken was the senior pastor of First Presbyterian Church of LaGrange, Illinois. Previously, Ken and his wife, Tassie, were associate pastors at Second Presbyterian Church of Indianapolis. Ken and his family live in Palatine, IL where Tassie is currently the Interim Pastor at FPC Evanston, and serves as the faculty lead for Interim Ministry training in the region.

Church Finances, End of Year, 2024 Preliminarily, Finance Committee reports that the gap between donations and costs, that had been projected as great as (\$600,000) for 2024 was dramatically reduced by extraordinary and beautiful giving as calendar year 2024 came to a close. This combined with careful attention to responsibly reducing costs greatly reduced, if not eliminated, that gap. We are still collecting final invoices for the year and ensuring that any gifts mailed and postmarked before the end of 2024 are correctly recorded in that budget year. We will release final results as soon as they become available, although we are confident in sharing that NPC ended 2024 with a much more favorable financial position, with our gratitude to the members and friends of Narberth Presbyterian Church.
